Senior Leaders Program

Success on the pitch requires hard work, persistence, and determination.

Success in life requires the same.

That's why we provide educational resources, emotional support, and leadership training. It's why we cultivate a supportive, tightknit community that pushes each of our kids forward, together, every single day.

The Senior Leaders Program needs your help to transform the lives of Philadelphia's underserved and immigrant youth.



Our Program

The Senior Leaders Program serves 100 teens annually. The core program, operating November through May, includes:

- Soccer and fitness training
- Competition in leagues and tournaments
- Health, nutrition, and injury prevention education
- Life skills and leadership curriculum
- Academic support, college guidance
- Career exposure, professional development workshops
- Community service
- Youth Council

Every participant is matched with a mentor, who helps them set and stay on track toward ambitious goals. Participants attend regular sessions and opt-in activities 2-4 days per week.

In the summer, our teens come in for soccer and drop-in mentoring, as well as work as coaches in our camps. We also connect them to leadership camps and special opportunities.



The success of our model is proven.

Not just by our 100% high school graduation rate, or 92% college enrollment rate, but by the pride, the poise, and the confidence of each of our participants.

Every day our kids find the star in themselves.

And every year, those stars are launched into adult society as engaged, responsible leaders who will positively impact the thousands of lives they will touch over a lifetime.
